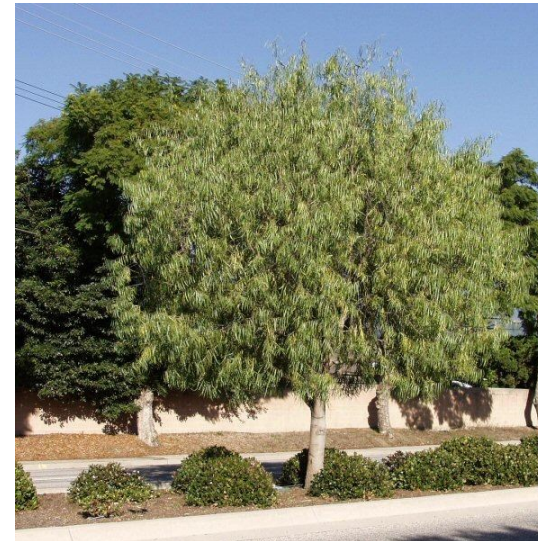
City of Live Oak - State Route 99 Tree Palette

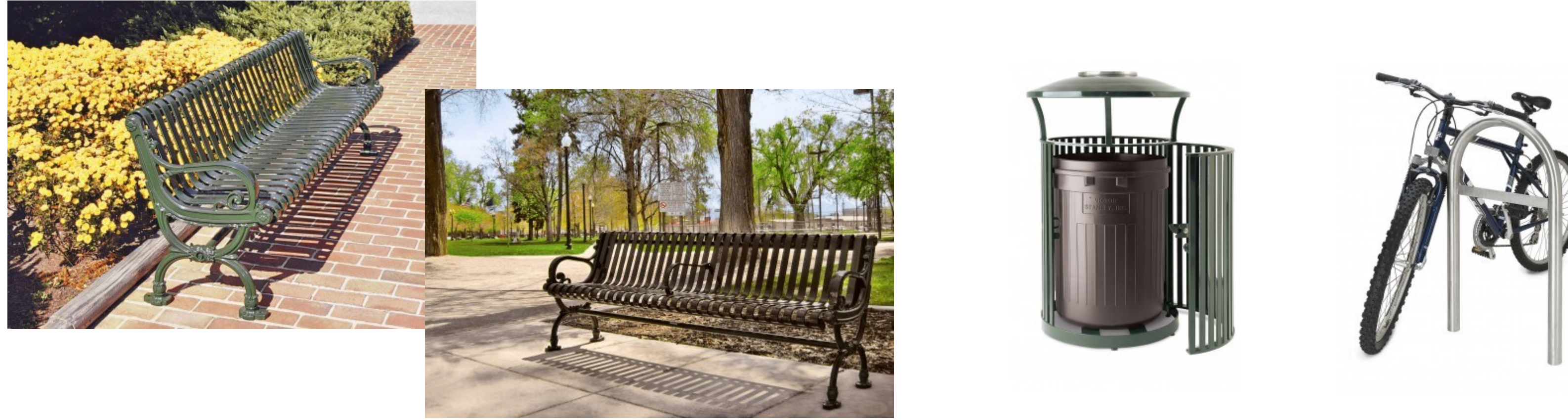

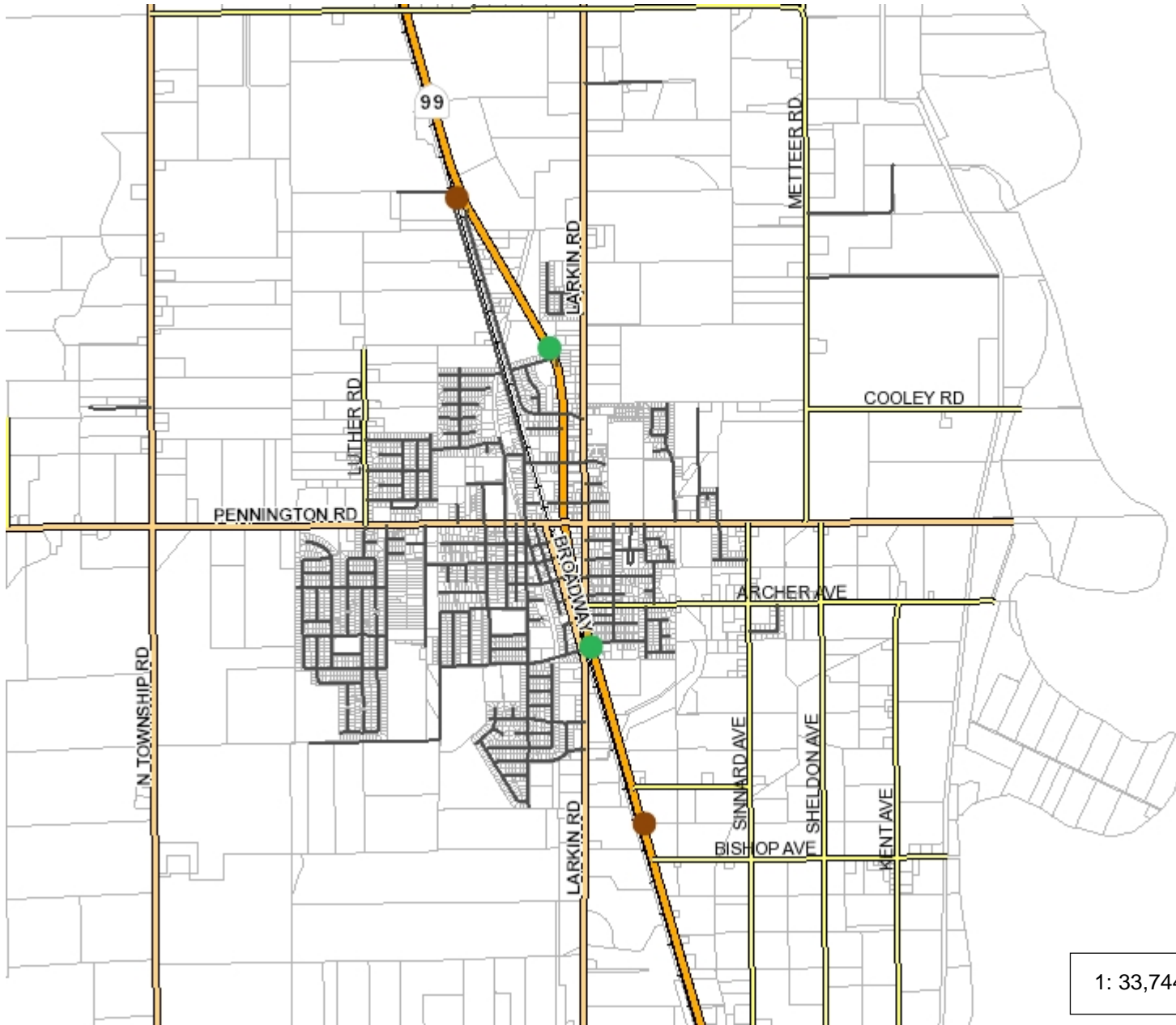

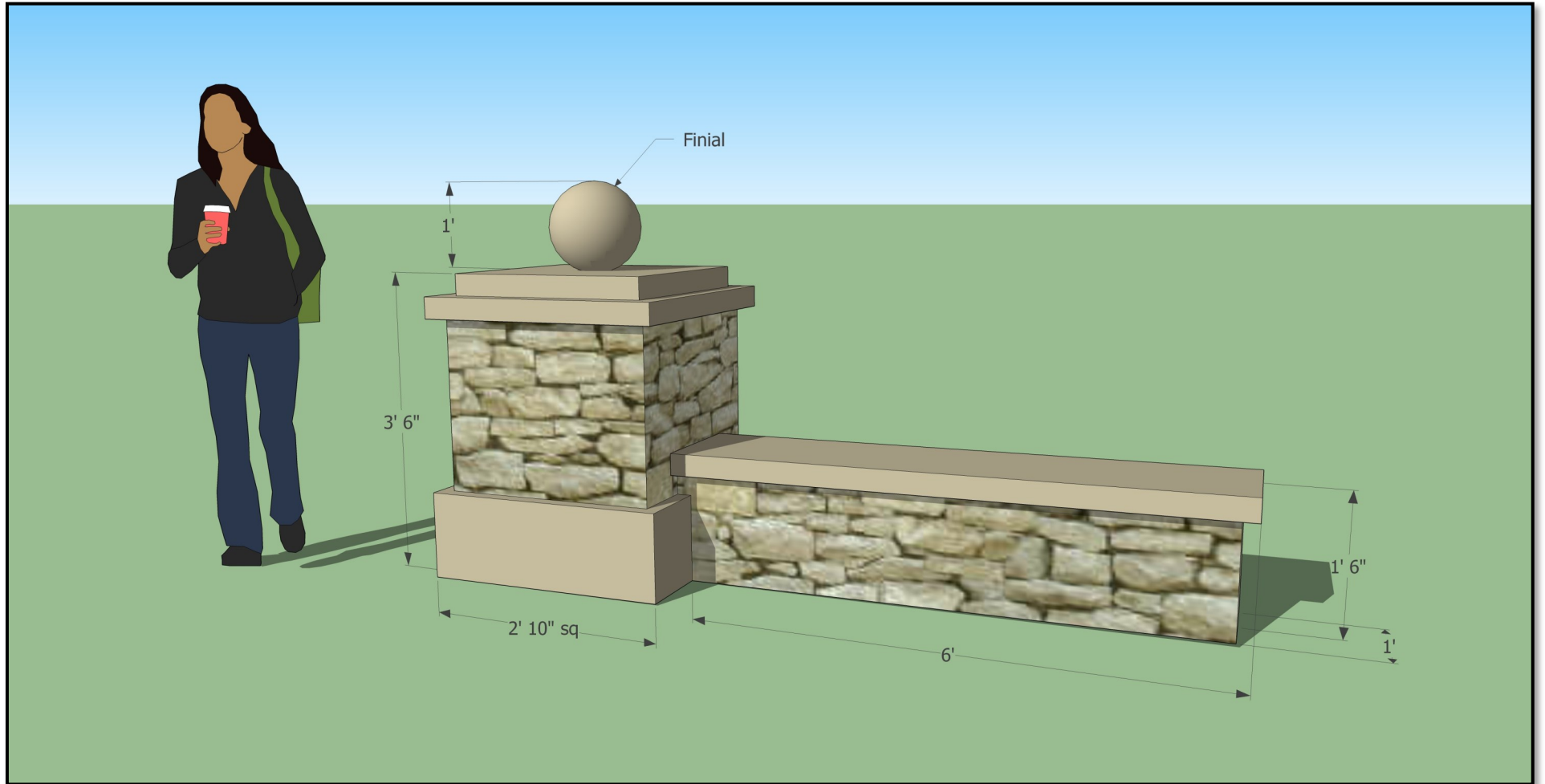

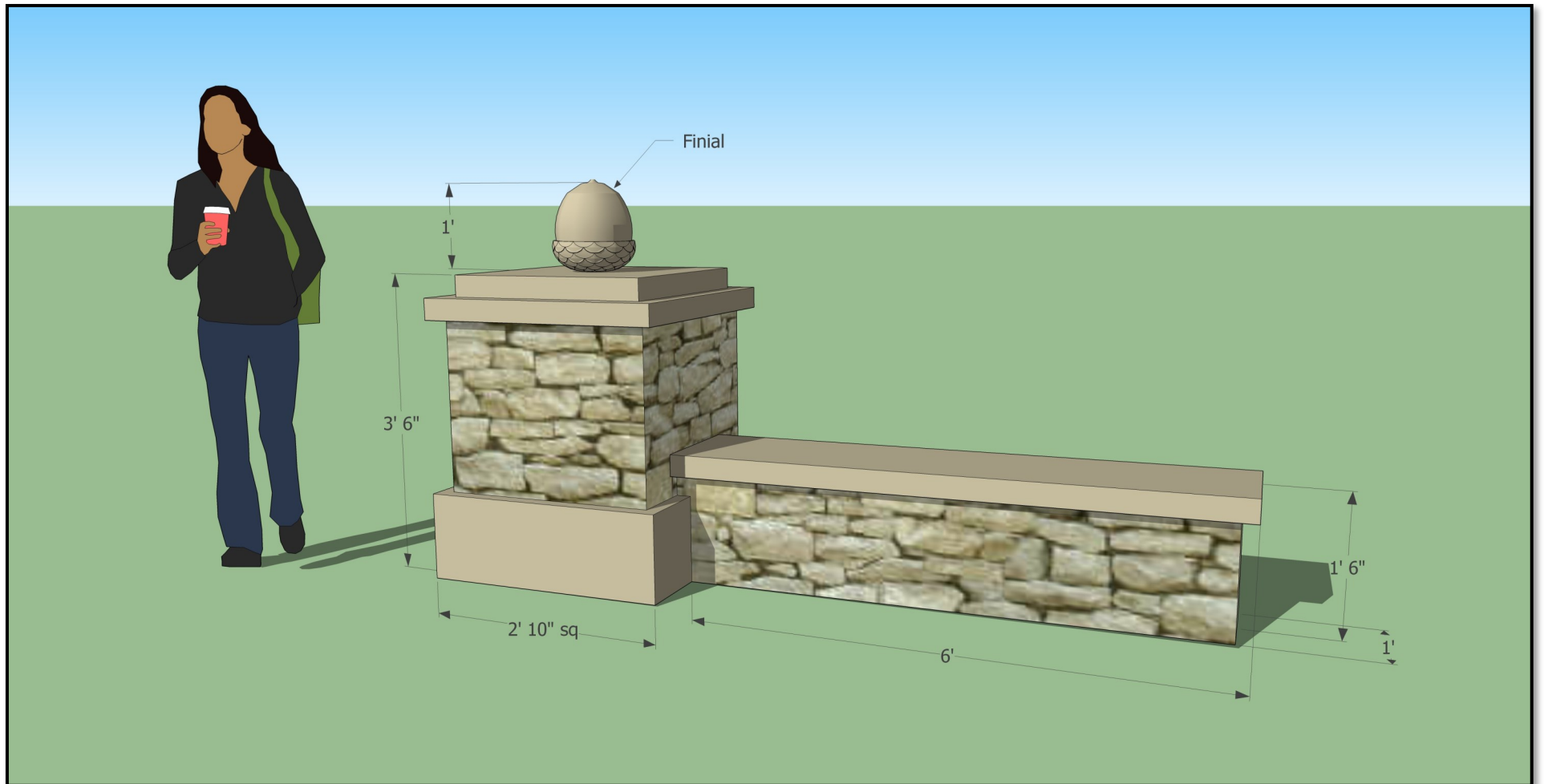

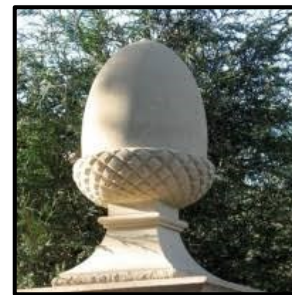
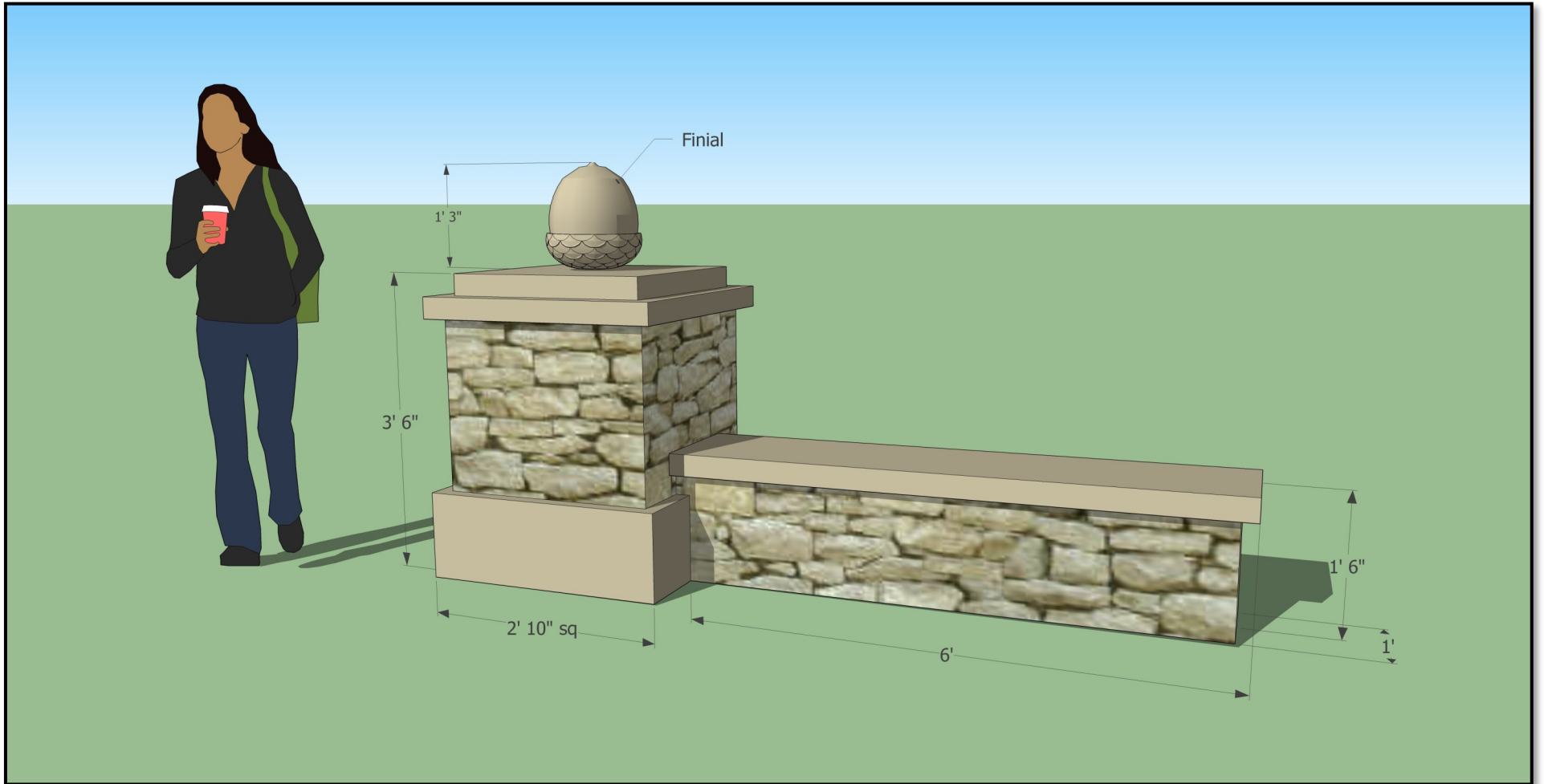


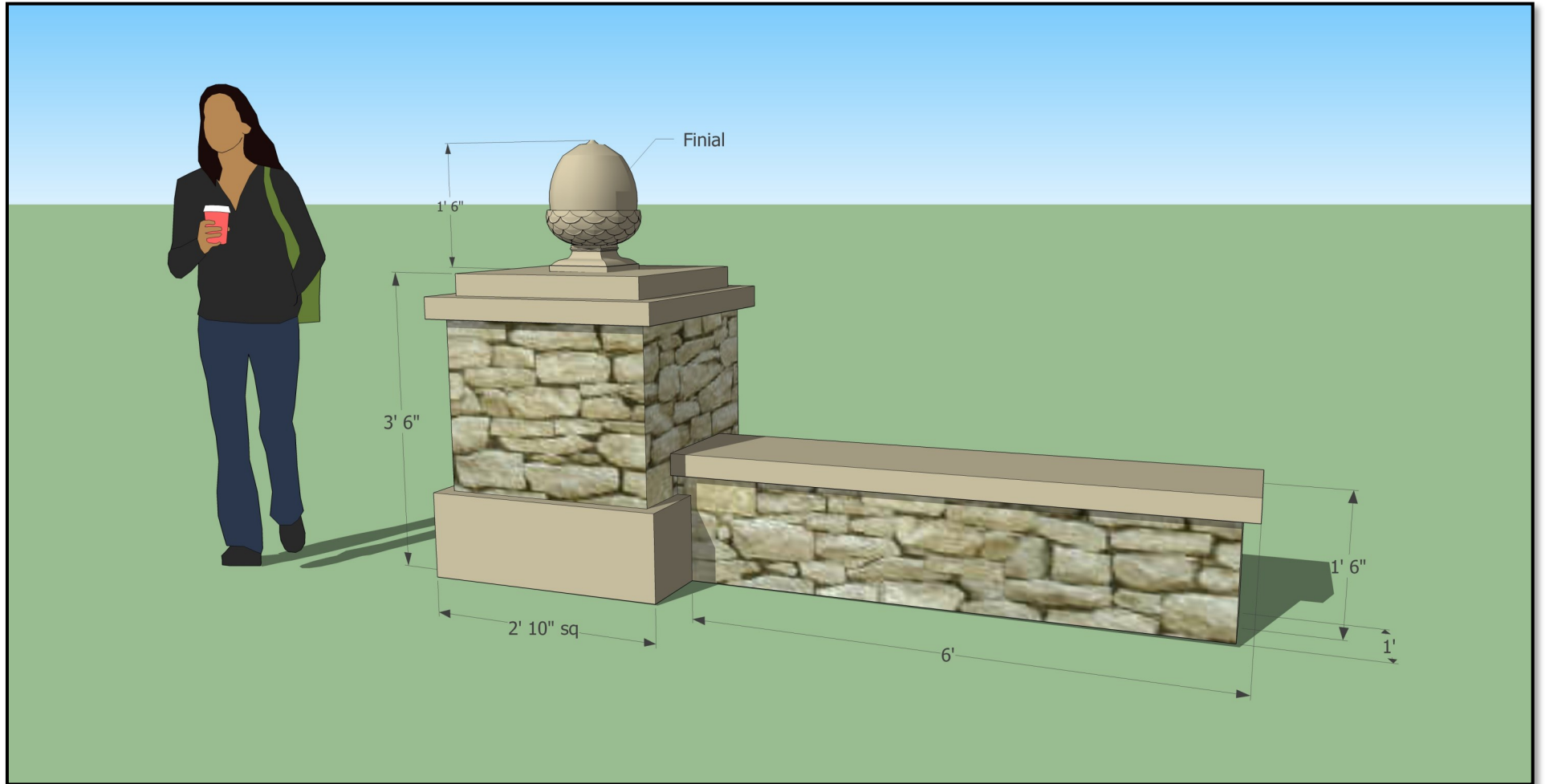
