Applied to traditional suburban neighborhoods, primarily consisting of detached single family residences and uses compatible with single family uses. This zone district can be applied throughout the City where low density residential uses are deemed appropriate. The R-1 Zone District is consistent with the Low Density Residential General Plan designation.

Single Family Residence: A building containing one residence.

Residence: A building or portion thereof designed for occupancy by one family for living purposes,

having only one kitchen.

Minimum and maximum

Density: 2-6 residences per acre

Minimum lot area: 6,000 sf. for interior lots

6,500 sf. for corner lots

May be reduced with approval by PC 5,000/5,500

<u>Minimum lot width:</u> 50 feet for interior lots

55 feet for corner lots

Maximum lot coverage: 40% for single story

35% for two-story

Minimum front yard: 15 feet, 20 foot for garage entrance

Side Yards: 5 feet, 10 feet for corner lots, 20 for garage entrance.

Minimum rear yard: 20 feet or 20% of lot depth, whichever is less

Building Height: Not to exceed a maximum of 2 stories or 30 feet.

<u>Landscaping:</u> Required on all new residences and on remodels or additions if the

cost exceeds 50% of the building value.

Parking: 2 spaces required, 9x18 each, asphalt or cement, must not be in the

required front yard

Recreational Vehicle

Parking: No parking in required front or street side yard. Includes RV, boat,

trailer, and any recreational vehicle
