COUNCIL AGENDA STAFF REPORT

SUBJECT: SR 99 Corridor Streetscape Master Plan

RECOMMENDATION: Review Master Plan

FISCAL IMPACTS: None

The City of Live Oak received a grant from Caltrans for preparation of a SR99 Corridor Streetscape Master Plan for the SR99 corridor from Paseo Road to Riviera Road. AECOM (formerly EDAW) was contracted to develop the plan and work began in early 2010.

The first public meeting was held June 28 and was attended by 20 people including representatives of AECOM (project consultants), Caltrans, City of Live Oak staff, and Sutter County Sheriff's Department, along with both Live Oak business owners and residents. A Technical Advisory Committee was formed subsequently with Mayor Baland and Councilmember Hodges designated as liaisons for the Council. The Technical Advisory Committee met in July, August, October and December to provide input in preparation of the plan.

AECOM Project Manager Matthew Gerkin will be present to provide an overview of the work completed to date.
